



**DRN15015 Drainage works on Rickmansworth Road (A404)**

Dear Householder,

Ringway on behalf of Hertfordshire County Council will shortly be carrying out highway drainage works on Rickmansworth Road (A404) – (Between the junction with Dog Kennel Lane and Christ Church).

The purpose of the works is to improve the drainage infrastructure along Rickmansworth Road and help with the highway flooding reported at this location.

The works are due to **start on Saturday 21<sup>th</sup> for 3 weeks**. However, due to the complex nature of the works, the first week of works between the junctions with Dog kennel Lane & Solesbridge Lane, works will be completed under 4/way lights, which will be manually controlled between 6:00-20:00. The remaining two weeks of works will be managed under 2/way lights and localised traffic management between Christ Church and Dog Kennel lane Junction.

Whilst access to emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times, other vehicular access will be restricted during the works duration. Access for residents will be maintained but you may encounter delays. Pedestrian access will not be affected.

We request that vehicles are **not parked** on the carriageway within this area during the times shown. This will allow the Contractor easy access to the road surface so the works can be undertaken as quickly as possible.

**For the most up-to-date information regarding the date and times of the road works, please refer to the information boards which will be placed on site prior to the works.**

We appreciate that these works are likely to cause congestion, and are therefore going to carry out, the most difficult sections during the schools holidays. We thank you for your patience during this period. If you would like further information on the forthcoming works please do not hesitate to contact us using the details shown below.
