A letter has been received from Three Rivers District Council advising that – an appeal has been made to the Secretary of State for the Environment under section 78 of the Town and country Planning Act, 1990 in respect of the above development. The appeal follows the refusal of planning permission by the Council for the following reasons:-

1. The proposed development fails to meet the requirements of Policy CP4 of the Core Strategy (adopted October 2011) and SPD Affordable Housing (approved June 2011) in that the scheme is for market dwelling and no contribution has been made towards the provision of affordable housing.

A letter has been received from Three Rivers District Council advising that – an appeal has been made to the Secretary of State for the Environment under section 78 of the Town and country Planning Act, 1990 in respect of the above development. The appeal follows the refusal of planning permission by the Council for the following reasons:-

- 1. The proposed development results in a form of backland development that fails to protect and maintain the character of the area in terms of layout, plot size, building footprint, landscaping and gaps between buildings and would result in unsatisfactory access and parking provision. It would have a detrimental impact on the character of the area and fails to meet the requirements of Policies CP1, CP3, CP10 and CP12 of the Core Strategy (adopted October 2011) and Policies DM1, DM13 and Appendices 2 and 5 of the Development Management Policies LDD (adopted July 2013).
- 2. The scheme is for two market dwellings and in the absence of an agreement under the provisions of Section 106 of Town and Country Planning Act 1990 would fail to contribute to the provisions of Section of affordable housing. The proposed development therefore fails to meet the requirements of Policy CP4 of the Core Strategy (adopted October 2011) and the Affordable Housing Supplementary Planning Document (approved June 2011).
