

## **HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

### **THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING OF SHIRE LANE, CHORLEYWOOD) ORDER 2018**

NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all traffic from using that length of Shire Lane, Chorleywood from its junction with Haddon Road south westwards to its junction with Burfield Road ("the Road"), a distance of approximately 166 metres, except for access.

An alternative route will be via Shire Lane, Station Approach, Common Road, A404 (Rickmansworth Road/Chorleywood Road), A412 (Rectory Road/Uxbridge Road/Denham Way), Long Lane, Heronsgate Road and Shire Lane.

The Order is needed because works are proposed to be executed on or near the Road.

If the Order is made, it shall come into force on 7 January 2019 for a period of up to 18 months. However, the restrictions specified shall only take effect at the times indicated by signs on or near the Road.

A copy of the proposed Order may be inspected free of charge at County Hall, Hertford between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm (excluding weekends, bank and public holidays).
