**THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TEMPORARY CLOSING AND TEMPORARY WAITING
RESTRICTIONS IN LONG LANE, HERONSGATE/HERONSGATE ROAD,
CHORLEYWOOD) ORDER 2019**

NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council intends to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to prohibit all traffic from using that length of Long Lane, Heronsgate/Heronsgate Road, Chorleywood from its junction with the M25 (junction 17)/A412 Denham Way roundabout north westwards to its junction with Bullisland Lane ("the Road"), a distance of approximately 1560 metres, except for access.

An alternative route will be via A412 (Denham Way/Uxbridge Road/Rectory Road), A404 (Chorleywood Road/Rickmansworth Road), Common Road, Station Approach, Shire Lane and Heronsgate Road.

ADDITIONALLY all vehicles are prohibited from waiting at any time on both sides of this length of the Road whilst works are in progress.

The Order is needed because works are proposed to be executed on or near the Road.

If the Order is made, it shall come into force on 1 April 2019 for a period of up to 18 months. However, the restrictions specified shall only take effect at the times indicated by signs on or near the Road.

A copy of the proposed Order may be inspected free of charge at County Hall, Hertford between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm (excluding weekends, bank and public holidays).
